- Staff attendance at PTO meetings - Elyse and Kalista visited in December with our Building Leadership Team (BLT) about additional teacher/staff attendance at meetings. For some background information, our BLT is a group of 14 teachers who lead and coordinate activities and roll-out initiatives for United. Kalista is a member of our BLT as our "PTO Teacher Representative and 6th Grade Play Coordinator". This specific BLT position started at the beginning of the 2024-25 school year for the purpose of improving two-way communication between the "P" and "T" of PTO and to further engage United staff in PTO events.
