
Boone, lowa – The United Community School District urges community members passionate about education to consider running in the school board election. That's exactly what school board members do—and this November, you could be one of them.

School board members play significant roles in their communities—they must have leadership, vision and dedication. They are charged with accountability for student learning, determining educational goals, setting policy, overseeing school finances, and more.

On **November 4, 2025**, the United Community School District will hold elections for two open school board seats—one in **District 2** and one **At-Large**. School board members are elected for four-year terms and serve without pay, but those who step into the role often say the rewards far outweigh the time and effort. The satisfaction comes from knowing your work helps children grow, families thrive, and communities stay strong.

You'll need signatures from at least 1% of the district's qualified electors or 50 electors, whichever is less, but no fewer than 10 signatures.
