#### Who is Eligible?

**Anyone can apply for financial assistance.** If your camper is interested in attending camp, but the cost of registration is not within your budget, we encourage you to apply for financial assistance. All financial assistance applications are kept confidential.

#### What Does Funding Cover?

Financial assistance may cover partial to full registration costs. While we strive to honor as many requests as possible, submitting an application for financial assistance is not a guarantee that funding will be available. In many cases, financial assistance may reduce, but not eliminate the full cost of registration. We strive to find the right balance between providing financial assistance to support your budget and offering assistance to as many campers as our budget will allow.

#### When Should I Apply?

We encourage you to apply for financial assistance as soon as possible. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis and assistance will be awarded until funds are depleted.

#### **How Much Assistance Can I Apply for?**

Financial assistance is available for one week of camp for a camper during each season.



#### How Do I Apply?

Applications are completed and submitted online. Follow the instructions below to apply:

- Visit Iowa Wildlife Camps website to find the REGISTER BUTTON (link above)
- 2. Create an account
- 3. Find "Document Center" in the left menu bar
- Fill out 2024 Financial Assistance Application form and submit.

#### What Next?

After you have submitted an application, you will receive an an email from lowa Wildlife Camps confirming if your request for assistance can be accommodated. This email will include the amount of assistance we are able to provide your camper as well as next steps in registering for camp.

#### **Tiered Pricing is Always Available**

Tiered pricing allows families to select a fee for camp registration that most aligns with their families' budget without applying for financial assistance. Tiered pricing is available for all camp offerings. There are three fee options from which you may choose. More information about tiered pricing can be found on our website.
